

STEP ONE!

How to register.

Fill out and mail the registration form and signed declaration form. Please include your camp fees or a \$20 deposit. Payment can be made by direct credit, cash or cheque, payable to: SONRISE STATION, 221 Matakitaki Road, R.D.5, Tuakau.

STEP TWO!

What do I bring?

PLEASE NAME ALL YOUR BELONGINGS!!!

People stuff: Sleeping bag / pillow / seam sealed raincoat / warm clothes or thermals / riding helmet or bicycle helmet / riding boots, gumboots or shoes with a heel / old clothes that can get muddy / togs / bible / pen / toiletries / plastic bags for wet dirty clothes.

Helmet and Jacket Hire: If you do not own a suitable Helmet or Raincoat either can be hired from Sonrise Station for \$5.00 each

Canteen will be available during camp time. Please bring extra money if you wish to buy canteen food. **No I.O.U.'s**. Hand in your canteen money when you register on the first day, we will deduct from this amount during camp, then give you your change when you leave on the last day.

Horsy Stuff: (If you are bringing your own horse).

You must supply all tack / cover / supplementary feed / extra saddle blankets / grooming gear / electric tape and standards if your horse has to graze separately.

DECLARATION

All information collected in this form is for the use of Sonrise Station only and is used solely for mail outs, follow up, and administration. Photographs may be used for promotional purposes.

Campers are in the care of leaders at all times and are expected to abide by the camp rules.

Sonrise Station will not accept registrations from campers who would constitute a danger to themselves or other people.

Please do not come to camp if you have had vomiting or had diarrhoea in the last 48 hrs prior to camp commencing.

Sonrise Station will supply grazing for your horse, although depending on the season supplementary feed may be required. This feed is the responsibility of the horse owner. Please check with the staff at Sonrise if you are unsure about your horse's needs.

- I am aware that horse riding does involve an element of risk.
- I consent to all the information supplied on this form being used for the purpose of running the camps and agree to abide by the camp rules.
- In the event of sickness or accident I authorize that qualified medical attention be secured, and notification followed by any expenses be billed to me at my stated address.
- I agree that the staff and leaders will be clear of all liability in the event of any injury or loss which the camper may sustain to person or property.
- I agree that the organizers, land owners and land managers will be cleared of all liability in the event of an accident or loss of person or property occurring on their land.
- If bringing my own horse I guarantee that my horse is in good health, free of coughs, colds and disease. That it has been drenched, and in suitable physical condition for riding on hill country.
- I agree to have a vet called in the event of injury to the horse and the bill be sent to my stated address.
- If the vet recommends euthanasia and the owner of the injured horse cannot be contacted, I give authority to the staff at Sonrise Station to make the decision to euthanise on behalf of the owner.
